Professor Chang Chiung Chih
Taiwan

Dr. Chiung Chih Chang is a Director, Physician, and Professor of General Neurology at Kaohsiung Chang Gung Memorial Hospital. She graduated from National Taiwan University and has been a recipient of the 2018 Chang Gung Research Award.

She is also well known as a specialist, certified in Neurology and Behavior Neurology. Her ongoing projects include a Phase III multicentre, randomized, double blind placebo-controlled, parallel-group study to evaluate the efficacy of aducanumab (BIIB037) in subjects with early Alzheimer's Disease. Dr. Chiung's focus is in Neurology and Behaviour Neurology, she has published extensively with regards to her expertise both locally and internationally.



Professor Hiroaki Kazui
Japan

Dr. Hiroaki Kazui is the Professor and Chairman of the Department of Neuropsychiatry at Kochi Medical School, Kochi University since 2018. He graduated from Tottori University, School of Medicine in 1989 and specialized in Neuropsychiatry at Osaka University in 1995. Dr. Hiroaki's astute medical expertise and experience can be seen through his membership at the Japanese Psychogeriatric Society, Japanese Society of Psychiatry and Neurology, International Psychogeriatric Association, International Society for Hydrocephalus, and Cerebrospinal Fluid Disorders, just to name a few. His major research topics include early diagnosis of dementia, treatment of behavioral and psychological symptoms of dementia, idiopathic normal pressure hydrocephalus, dementia with Lewy bodies and also, neuropsychology.

Dr. Chavit Tunvirachaisakul is a Lecturer at the Geriatric Psychiatry Unit at the Department of Psychiatry, Faculty of Medicine at Chulalongkorn University. He got his PhD. in Old Age Psychiatry in 2020 from the Institute of Psychiatry, Psychology, and Neuroscience, King's College London. Dr. Chavit's area of interest includes geriatric depression, neuropsychiatry, healthcare informatics, and machine learning. He helps running a comprehensive dementia service in King Chulalongkorn Memorial Hospital.
